The Colorado Renewable Energy Society is pleased to announce its Call for Entries for the
2012 Renewable Energy and Sustainable Design in Buildings Awards for Architects, Contractors, Owners and Builders.

- The awards aim to encourage the use of renewable energy and sustainable design strategies or technologies that can be directly applicable to Colorado's unique climate and building needs. These include the demonstration of effective use of rating systems, custom proof of concepts using passive or natural building methods, photovoltaics, solar thermal water or space heating, heat pump technology, energy solutions using wind power, geothermal technologies/techniques, daylighting, natural ventilation or others. Performance in strategy must be proven through utility data.
- Awards will be presented at the **2012 Colorado Renewable Energy Conference** which will be combined this year with the **World Renewable Energy Forum**, May 13-17, 2012, at the Colorado Convention Center in Denver.
- Media releases about the award winners will be distributed to major state and local media.
- Photos of and information about the award winners will be featured on the CRES web site.
